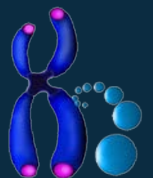

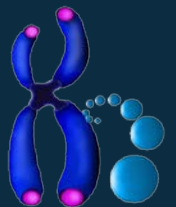

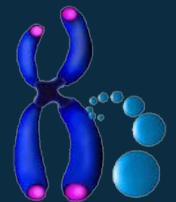

Presenting author's name underlined, affiliations italicised and paragraph alignment justified. Place a 12-point space before the first paragraph and a 6-point space before any subsequent paragraphs.

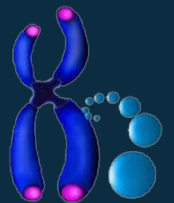

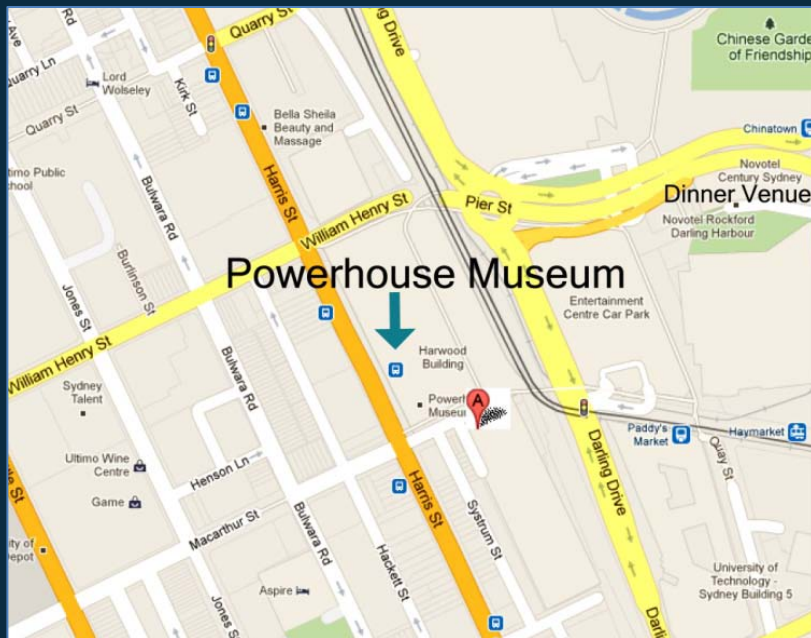
## **Prize**

Across the road is the Powerhouse Museum.

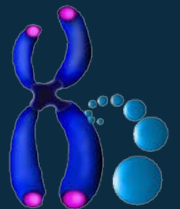
